Paul will bring the Festival supplies from the Community Center. The Committee still has 3 pop-up tents there. Joe Pater will contact Greg Elam to see if he has any tents to donate.

Earl Hendrick's may try to set up bands for Sunday. Joe Pater will also try to contact a band to play on Sunday. Talent show prizes will be \$5.00 McDonald's gift cards. Angie would like to make up gift baskets for the bands that are performing for free. Dianna moved and Paul seconded and the committee approved.

Joe Pater has the stage sign framework made by Butler County Lumber. It will be brought to the park Friday morning, Sept.8.

John reported the Parade is looking good.

There will be a road closure at Nichols Rd and 177 Sept.5-8<sup>th</sup>. Hopefully it will be open by the 9<sup>th</sup> for the festival.
